

TEAM EVENTS WITH AGGREGATE SCORING

All team events will use best ball/aggregate scoring in match competition.

A better title for this format is team match play “with total net”.

For each hole two points are awarded, one for low net and a second point awarded to the two-player team with the lowest net total. There are three outcomes: you can win 2 pts, win 1 pt, or push the hole. For example, you can push a hole if your team has low ball but your opponents have a lower total net score on the hole. After 18 holes the team with the most points wins the match.

Here's an example.

PLAYER	A	B	C	D
HANDICAP	6	15	9	10

They are playing hole #1 which is a par 4 and is handicap 9. All players are stroking except player 'A'.

PLAYER	A	B	C	D
Hole Score	4	7	6	5
Net Score	4	6	5	4

A-B team has a total net of 10 and the C-D team has a total net of 9.

Neither team wins the low-ball point. The C/D team wins the “aggregate point”. One point for the C-D team and on to the next hole.

Note: Unlike individual match play or the old team best ball ONLY format, **individual holes are NOT counted as won or lost towards match status.** All that matters is the number of points won/lost (if any) per hole as the match runs its course. Here's an example with teams 'X' and 'Y'.

Hole	Result	Match Status
1	Team X gets 1 pt	Team X is up 1 point
2	Team Y gets 2 pts	Team Y is up 1 point
3	No blood	Team Y remains up 1 point
